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# TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

## Indemnification and Release Waiver

Prior to playing your first game you are required to submit the attached Acknowledgement of Indemnification and Release signed by all players. The waiver form must be handed in prior to your first game, or you will not be allowed on the field. This Waiver can be submitted at Team Registration, at the Tournament Office or at the Game Controller's Booth.

## Accreditation

Team registration will take place on August 14<sup>th</sup> at Budd Park. The registration table will be located in the main building and will be open from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Team and family passes will be distributed at registration based on the information you provide in your August 6<sup>th</sup> roster. Changes to that roster must be verified by the ISC II Statistician. Please note that family is defined as "living under the same roof". Children under 12 are admitted free of charge to the park. Please **do not** include the names of children under 12 on your roster. Family Pass requests must be accompanied with proof of address with photo (driver's license) that the family member has the same address as the player

## Opening Ceremonies

The Opening Ceremonies take place on Diamond 1 at Budd Park starting at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, August 14. Teams will assemble on the outfield grass area behind your Team Name Sign at 6:15 pm. We will then have introductions of the teams, Umpires, ISCII personnel, followed by "Welcome To" speeches, and the National Anthems. This should not take much longer than 1/2 Hour.

## Practice Diamonds

Our practice diamond coordinator, Gary Boug, will attend the Manager's meeting to outline the process for booking practice fields. Throughout the tournament Gary will be located in at Peter Hallman Ball Yard (number 15 on the enclosed Park Plan). He can be contacted by telephone and that number will be provided in the Manager's Package distributed at the meeting. Gary will help you to book practice fields at locations and times convenient for your team.

## Dearborn Health Performance and Wellness Centre

Dr. Paul Brown of Dearborn Health Performance and Wellness is the tournament Medical Director. A Medical tent is set up at the Peter Hallman Ball Yard to provide first aid as well as pre and post game therapy, recovery techniques, injury management and performance enhancement. Tournament of Champions players are welcome to use these services as required. A separate page in this package provides additional details and Clinic hours.

## Alcohol Policy

Alcoholic beverages will be sold in the park in the Beer Tent. For your enjoyment and the enjoyment of our fans and participants we ask that you and your players understand and respect the following guidelines.

The Province of Ontario has restrictive legislation regarding the consumption of alcohol at public events. Your Host Committee will operate beverage gardens in all parks under the authority of a Special Occasion Permit. We are subject to inspection by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission. Any infractions of the law can result in the revocation of our license.

***Beverage Consumption***

Alcohol may be consumed only in the fenced area of the licensed beer garden. Drinking in parking lots or in other areas of the park cannot be tolerated. Our security staff will be monitoring those areas.

***Personal Beverages***

Personal alcoholic beverages cannot be brought into the parks. We reserve the right to check coolers and bags at the gate and alcohol will be confiscated. Consumption of alcohol that has not been purchased on site is an infraction of the legislation and offenders can be charged.

***Beverage Service***

Legislation stipulates that only two alcoholic beverages can be served at a time to one person.

***Designated Driver Program***

Driving under the influence of alcohol is a serious offence in the Province of Ontario. We are pleased to provide a safe ride home from the Ball Yard if it required. This service can be requested either in the Beer Garden at the Ticket Sales Booth or at the Tournament Office.

On-site Medical Services**

**First Aid:** Dearborn Health Performance & Wellness will be providing first aid coverage for the duration of the tournament at the Peter Hallman Ball Yard (PHBY). Services will include CPR and basic first aid to all persons attending or participating in the 2007 tournament while at the PHBY. Daily coverage will begin 30 minutes before the first scheduled game continuing until 30 minutes after the end of the final game. An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) will be onsite for the duration of the tournament and will be kept in the medical tent.

**Medical Tent:** The medical tent will consist of a multi-disciplinary team of sports physicians, chiropractors, physiotherapists, massage therapists, athletic therapists and pedorthists. Scheduled clinic hours for the assessment and treatment of players and team personnel will entail two 3 hour clinic sessions daily and are outlined in detail below. If numbers from the previous tournaments hosted in 2002 and 2006 are any indication, this will be a very busy clinic. Over 900 treatments were provided consisting of pre and post game therapy, recovery techniques, injury management and performance enhancement.

- **Cost:** Services will be provided *free of charge to all players and team personnel* on a ‘first come, first served’ basis within the following framework:
  1. Injuries demanding immediate attention will receive highest priority
  2. Pre-game treatment supersedes post-game treatment
- **Paperwork** including personal and past medical information, informed consent, and a legal release will be required to be completed prior to any treatment or assessment in the medical tent.
- **Non-residents of Canada** will be required to complete a Governing Law and Jurisdiction Agreement prior to any treatment or assessment in the medical tent.
- **Ontario residents** will be required to provide their OHIP number prior to any treatment or assessment provided by a sports physician.
- **Radiographs** will be requisitioned as necessary at no charge.
- **Tertiary Care:** An urgent care facility is located at the corner of Fairway Rd. and Wilson Ave. Average wait times for the month of August are ½ - 2 hours and there is no “preferred status” granted to tournament participants. Non-residents of Canada will be charged \$100 for initial assessment with additional procedural fees applied as warranted.

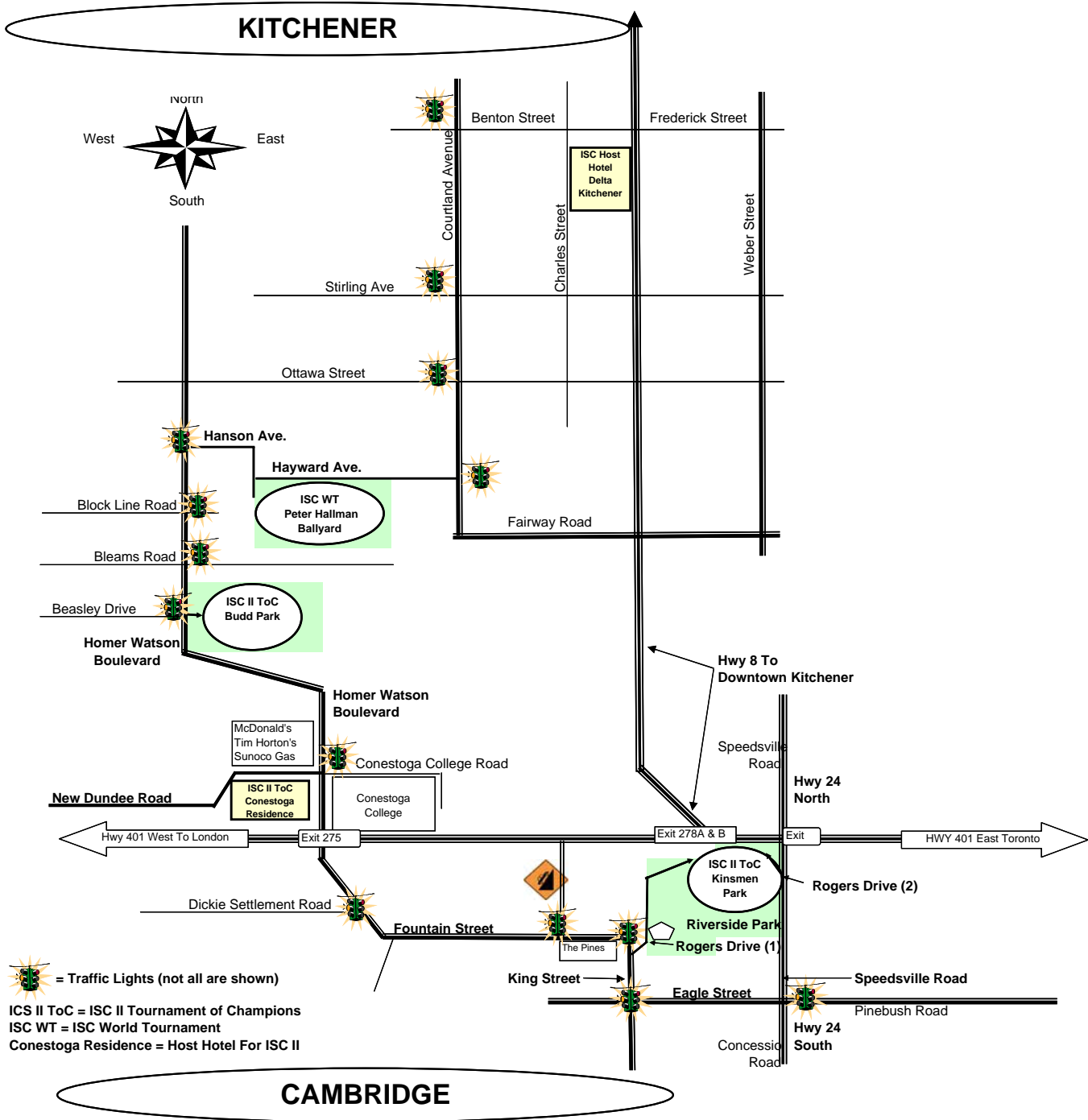

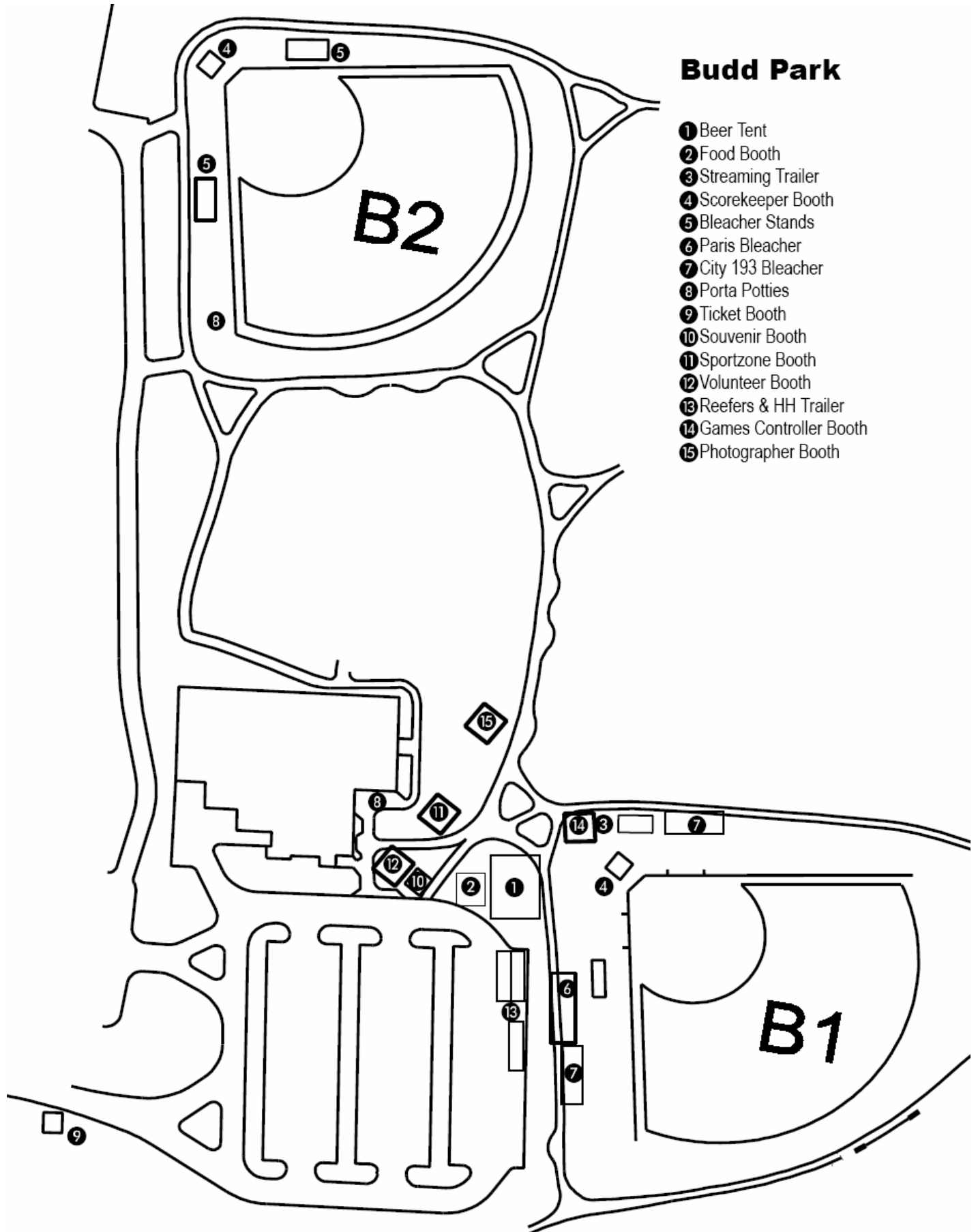
**Kinsmen Park Entrance**

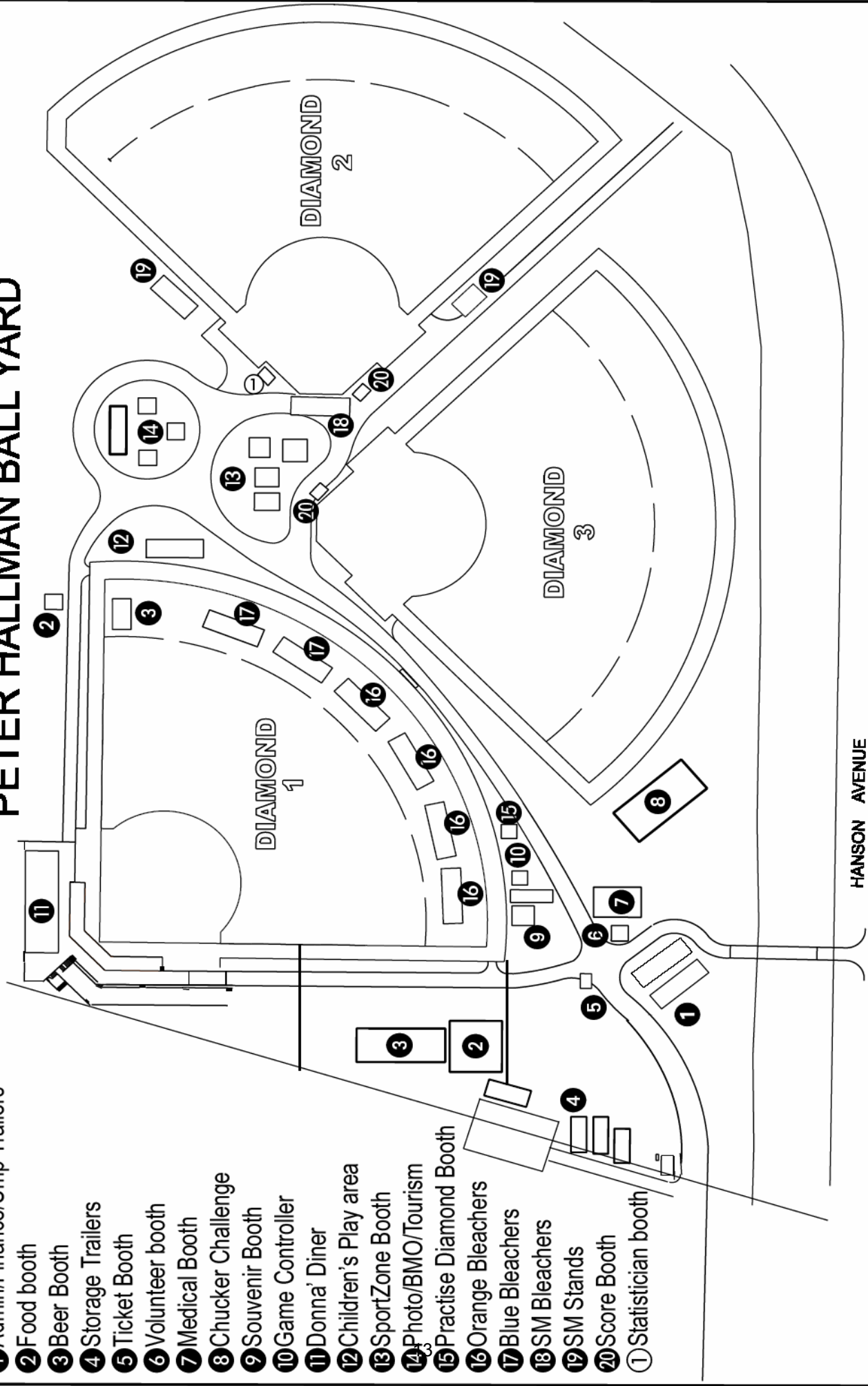

# Tourism Information

## Getting Here

Kitchener is located in Southern Ontario 100 kms (60 miles) west of Toronto, 230 kms (180 miles) east of Windsor/Detroit and 175 kms (110 miles) northwest of Buffalo. Kitchener is easily accessible by ground or air. All major airlines fly to Pearson International Airport in Toronto and Northwest and WestJet Airlines provide daily service to the **Region of Waterloo International Airport**. Pearson International Airport has car rental kiosks on the arrivals level. Ground transportation is also available from Airways Transit. Advance reservations are recommended. Visit their website at [www.airwaystransit.com](http://www.airwaystransit.com) for online reservations and contact information.

## Driving Directions

From **Toronto and Windsor/Detroit** follow Hwy 401 to Homer Watson Boulevard (Exit 275). After exiting on the ramp turn right (from Toronto) or left (from Windsor) and continue on Homer Watson for five miles. Turn right on Hanson Avenue, and you'll drive right into the Park.

From **Buffalo and Fort Erie**, follow the Queen Elizabeth Way North to Hwy 403 West to Hwy 6 North to Hwy 401. Then take Hwy 401 West to Homer Watson Boulevard (Exit 275) and follow directions above.

To get to every hotel, except the Conestoga Residence, take Hwy 401 to Exit 278 if westbound or Exit 278B if eastbound, onto Hwy 8, and head north into the city of Kitchener.

For the Conestoga Residence, take Hwy 401 to Exit 275 Homer Watson Boulevard and travel north for one block. Turn left on New Dundee Road and the hotel is on your left.

## US Visitors to Ontario

**Travel by Air:** As of January 23, 2007, all persons, including U.S. Citizens, travelling by air between the United States and Canada are required to present a valid passport or Air NEXUS card, according to a new American law, the Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI). The U.S. Departments of State and Homeland Security announced on June 8, 2007, that U.S. citizens traveling to Canada who have applied for, but not yet received, passports can temporarily enter and depart from the United States by air with a government issued photo identification and Department of State official proof of application for a passport through Sept. 30, 2007.

**Travel by Land:** US Visitors can continue to use such documents as their birth certificates and drivers' licences to cross the Canada-U.S. border by land until as early as January 1, 2008, though may be asked to verify their citizenship with such documents as a passport or a birth certificate. Naturalised U.S. citizens should carry a naturalisation certificate. Permanent U.S. residents who are not citizens are advised to bring their Alien Registration Receipt Card (Green Card).

## Vehicle Rental

HERTZ will provide special pricing for attendees to the tournament when renting locally in Kitchener, Cambridge and Waterloo. Vehicles must be reserved in advance by calling Hertz Kitchener locally at 519-579-3200.
