Eligibility: Per ASA rules: Age Verification & Picture I.D.

Required (Article 501,502). Players not in

compliance with these rules will not be allowed to participate. Each team must have one coach

within the field of play/dugout to be ACE

Certified.

General Regulations:

- 1. Team coaches must have full control of their players at all times including on and off the field.
- In case of a perceived misapplication of a playing rule, team coach or captain may consult game officials. Other players, assistants, coaches or sponsors are to be kept out of the discussions. Judgment plays may not be protested.
- Managers/coaches are to report any unsportsmanlike or derogatory acts by players or spectators or any report by hotel management of destruction of property or abuse of hotel property or other inappropriate action to the Tournament Director.
- 4. Players/managers ejected from a game for unsportsmanlike act likely will be disqualified from tournament play. A hearing will be held.

Parking: Free parking is available on the west side of the

complex nearest to fields 1 and 4. Additional parking is available in front of the main gate closest to fields 1 and 2 and on the east side of the complex

nearest fields 5 and 6.

Admission: Daily admission: Adults \$5, Children 12 & Under \$3.

Concessions: A variety of concessions will be available. No

outside food or drink is allowed in the park.

Awards: Team plaques will be awarded to first and second

place finishers. Individual awards to champion and

Game Time: Times listed are only a guideline. Teams should be

ready to play after the conclusion of the preceding

game.

Line-ups: Cards will be provided. A copy must be submitted

to the scorekeeper 15 minutes prior to start time. First and last names must be legible along with

iersey number.

Coin-flip: A coin will be flipped 15 minutes prior to the start

time to determine home and visitor teams.

Dugouts: The team listed on the top of the bracket will use the

dugout along the third base line.

Infield Practice: No infield practice will be allowed. Teams may

warm up in designated areas while the infield is

being prepared.

Run Rule: Twelve runs after three or eight runs after the fifth

inning.

Uniforms: All players and coaches must comply with ASA

uniform code Rule 3, Section 6, which means matching numbered shirts and matching pants and/or shorts. Striping on pants or shorts need not match. Final interpretation by the Umpire-in-Chief. Hats must be worn. Metal spikes for 23 & under only. Rule 3, Section 5: Those 18 & under must

wear helmets with mask and chinstraps.

Bats: Bats must be presented for approval ahead of time

to the game umpire.

Official Balls: Dudley Red Stitch, Optic Yellow Polycore & FP Ball

47 core, 375 compression will be used. Two new balls will be provided and used during each game.

Alcohol: The legal drinking age in Minnesota is 21 years old.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted in the Caswell

Park complex.
