A look back - CHYMrs / Twins - 1971



Local fastball fans of a certain vintage may recall the Waterloo CHYMrs, predecessors of today's Hallman Twins. The team was originally formed in 1967 and sponsored by Bridge Sports, and in 1970 by local radio station CHYM 1490. In the mid-late 1980s the new-look Twins emerged – perhaps honoring our Kitchener-Waterloo Twin Cities. CHYMr s won the 1971 OASA Senior "B" championship.



Today's noon hour presentation will be to the **Kitchener Minor Baseball Association** as a capital grant for the enhancement and expansion of batting cages at Breithaupt Park in Kitchener.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

If Kitchener Hallman Twins can maintain momentum and earn three more wins in a row (they're currently on a 5-game win streak after losing to Bloomington IL Stix on Wednesday), they'll be the first Host team in an ISC World Tournament to claim the championship in 23 Years.
