## **JIM SANDER** **PITCHER**

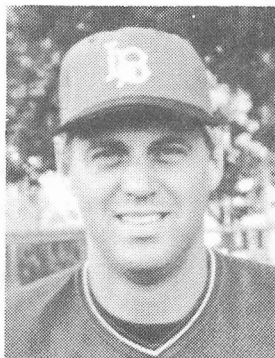

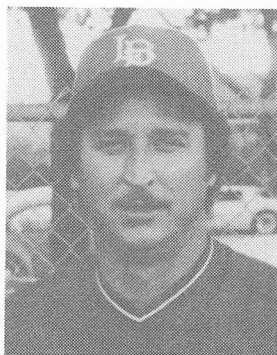
## DON FRAZIER COACH
